CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES INFORMATION

With the adoption of New York State Department of Health regulations on March 18, 1998 Registered Physician Assistants in the State of New York will be permitted to prescribe schedule III - V Controlled Substances. This authority can only be undertaken after a Registered Physician Assistant receives a Federal Drug Enforcement Administration number and only if the Registered Physician Assistant has been granted this authority by his or her supervising physician.

Narcotic Drugs

1. Not more than 1.8 Grams of Codeine per 100ml or 90 milligrams per dosage unit, with an equal or greater quantity of an isoquinoline alkaloid of opium.
2. Not more than 1.8 grams of Codeine per 100 or 90 mg per dosage unit, with one or more active nonnarcotic ingredients in recognized therapeutic amounts.
3. Not more than three hundred milligrams of dihydrocodeinone (hydrocodone) per 100ml or not more than 15 milligrams per dosage unit, with one or more active nonnarcotic ingredients in recognized therapeutic amounts.
4. Not more than three hundred milligrams of dihydricodeinone per 100ml or not more than 15 milligrams per dosage unit, with a fourfold or greater quantity of an isoquinoline alkaloid of opium.
5. Not more than 1.8 grams of dihydricodine per 100 ml or not more than 90 milligrams per dosage unit, with one or more active, nonnarcotic ingredients in recognized therapeutic amounts.
6. Not more than 500mg opium per 100ml or per 100 gram or not more than 25 milligrams per dosage unit, with one or more active, nonnarcotic ingredients in recognized therapeutic amounts.
7. Not more than 50 mg of morphine per 100 ml or grams, with one or more active, nonnarcotic ingredients in recognized therapeutic amounts.

SCHEDULE V

Narcotic Drugs Containing nonnarcotic active medicinal ingredients:

1. Not more than two hundred milligrams of codeine per one hundred milliliters or per one hundred grams.
2. Not more than one hundred milligrams of dihydrocodine per one hundred milliliters or per one hundred grams.
3. Not more than 2.5 milligrams of diphenoxylate and not less than twenty-five micrograms of atropine sulfate per dosage unit.
4. Not more than one hundred milligrams of opium per one hundred milliliters or grams.
5. Not more than .5 milligrams of difenoxin and not less than twenty-five micrograms of atrophine sulfate per dosage unit.
